Meeting started at 7:00 pm.

Administrator Updates: Current count at Capital is 1060 students. Study hall is going well. Administration is seeing a lower number of students with grade issues at the 6-week mark. Bellande encourages students to come to him with a “plan” on how they are going to improve their grades. The group discussed the push back tickets sellers are getting from people attending JV games.

Minutes from the September meeting were approved.

Treasurer’s Report: 31 memberships have been sold. Steve provided an update on the covered benches for soccer. Both the boys and girls teams have been asked to contribute to the cost. Olympia High School has also contributed. A motion to approve the expenditure of \$5,233 was made and approved.

Booster Club Membership: Membership is down. We need to focus on selling tickets to the fundraiser.

Concession/Ticket Sales: An agreement has been made with coaches. If one game can be covered for tickets and concession or one night of games the team will earn \$75. *Please spread the word that word of mouth between parents and teams helps fill shifts. It is also a great way to get the word out about the Booster Club.*

This event will feature boys and girls basketball games/scrimmages. There will also be a food drive. We need coverage in the concession stand from 4 – 9:30 or so.
